

Center for Epidemiological Studies Depression Scale for Children

(CES-DC)

The Center for Epidemiological Studies Depression Scale for Children (CES-DC) is a 20-item selfreport depression inventory with possible scores ranging from 0 to 60. Each response to an item is scored as follows:

- 0 = "Not At All"
- 1 = "A Little"
- 2 = "Some"
- 3 = "A Lot"

However, items 4, 8, 12, and 16 are phrased positively, and thus are scored in the opposite order:

3 = "Not At All" 2 = "A Little" 1 = "Some" 0 = "A Lot"

Higher CES-DC scores indicate increasing levels of depression. Weissman et al. (1980), the developers of the CES-DC, have used the cutoff score of 15 as being suggestive of depressive symptoms in children and adolescents. That is, scores over 15 can be indicative of significant levels of depressive symptoms.

Remember that assessing for depression can be complex and serves as merely a starting point. Additional assessment is necessary for children who are flagged through the screening process. Further evaluation is warranted for children displaying depressive symptoms even if they do not test positively during screening.
